

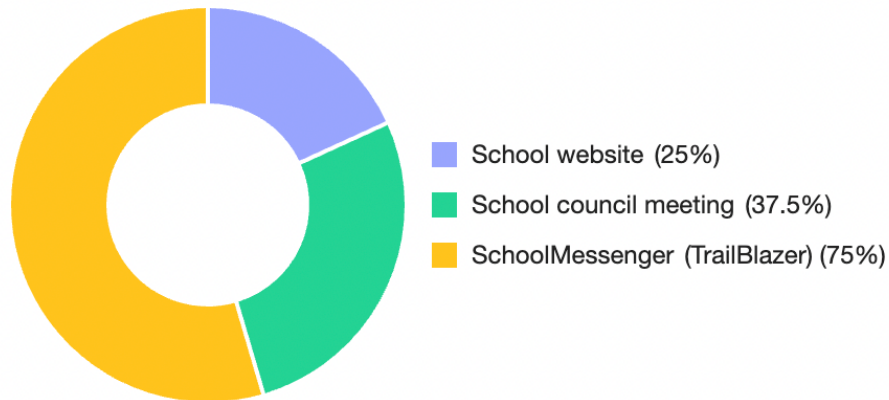

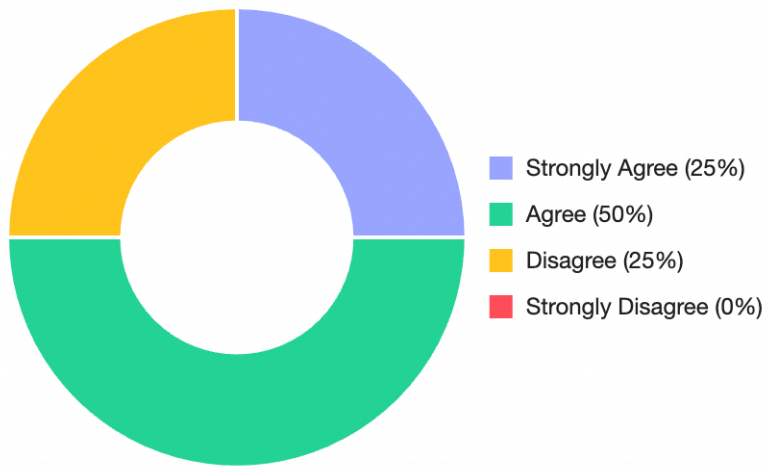

## (School Council Results)

### School Development Plan

**We share SDP information in different ways. What ways have you learned about it?**

- School Website – 33%
- School Council Meeting – 66%
- SchoolMessenger (TrailBlazer) – 100%

Council shared that they appreciate the multiple ways the SDP is shared.

**The SDP is developed with all students in mind, do you agree with that your child's learning can benefit from the goals, outcomes and actions and resources in the SDP? The learning of all students is reflected and prioritized in the goal(s), outcome(s), actions and resources in the SDP?**

Council shared that this is a difficult question for them to answer as many of their children already enjoy Math and that there are many factors that impact their child's engagement (example who their teacher is). The second question is a difficult question for them to answer as they do not know the learning needs of all the students in the school.

Council noticed that:

- their children see themselves as mathematicians
- sometimes they get confused with the different ways to solve a math problem
- sometimes it's hard to support their child at home with math
- new curriculum is hard and feel that there are gaps with their child
- wondered how complex students are supported
